



QUEBEC'S BILL 96 IS CAUSING INTOLERANCE AND HARDSHIP



The population of English-Speaking Quebec is greater than **FIVE** other Canadian provinces, yet

- Everyone's rights are now **SECONDARY** to French.
- English services are provided only to those **ELIGIBLE**, i.e. those who are:
 - Educated in English in Canada,
 - Indigenous persons,
 - Newcomers, but only for first six months.
- **BARRIERS** prevent English-speakers from:
 - Attending English schools and colleges,
 - Accessing information, courts and healthcare,
 - Benefiting from municipal services,
 - Operating a business in their language.
